1. Human Development

2. Democratic Governance and Peace

Governance, elections, etc.; Peace and Security, transnational threats, maritime security.
Culture.

3. Green & Climate transition

Renewable energy and regional interconnectivity; agri-food systems; biodiversity, environment and wildlife management; water basins

4. Digital, Science, Technology & Innovation

Digital transformation and digital connectivity
Science, Technology and Innovation

5. Sustainable Growth and Decent Jobs

Regional economic integration, trade & trade facilitation; strategic corridors (transport infrastructure – road, rail, ports);

sustainable finance, investment climate and private sector.

6. Migration and forced displacement

Return and readmission, migration management and legal migration; forced displacement; border management
