Research and Innovation (R&I)

<u>What is the EU-Africa High Level Policy Dialogue on</u> <u>Science Technology and Innovation?</u>

- Endorsed by Africa-EU Summit in <u>Tripoli in 2010</u>
- Fully embedded in the Joint EU-Africa Strategy (JAES)
- Platform for better common understanding, building trust and ownership, define and agree shared priorities, design and monitor implementation
- Brings together Senior officials from Research and Innovation Ministries in Africa and Europe, the EC and the AUC
- Supported by a Bureau
- High-level engagement
 - September 2011 in Addis Ababa
 - April 2016 (Addis Ababa)
 - October 2017 (Brussels)
 - October 2019 (Addis Ababa)
 - > July 2020 (Virtual) & Ministerial

Achievements: Conclusions 2011 meeting

- Mutual understanding of necessity to meet in the configuration of the EU-Africa HLPD
- Call to map study to assess existing bi-regional STI cooperation initiatives between EU and Africa to identify best practice models, gaps and effective financial mechanisms

Conclusions 2013 meeting

- Recognition of STI as driver of socio-economic development
- Focus the cooperation on **first priority area** for it to be more effective
- Development of a long-term "jointly funded and coowned research and innovation partnership" between the EU and Africa
- High Level Policy Dialogue on STI as key platform for priority-setting and implementation design in the future Joint Africa-EU Strategy (JAES)

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
- Identified common priorities and selected first one for action
 - "Role of STI in ensuring food and nutrition security and sustainable agriculture (including water)"
 - Priority endorsed at Africa-EU Summit in April 2014
 - Roadmap towards jointly financed R&I Partnership on FNSSA

First Priority Area

Role of science, technologyand innovation in ensuring"Food security, nutritionand sustainableagriculture"

An integrated STI approach, recognising the important cross-cutting nature of innovation, entrepreneurship, research infrastructures and technical competences strengthening Including the management of water resources for agriculture.

<u>Roadmap</u>: Outlines **short-, mediumand long-term** steps and milestones towards the establishment of a longterm R&I Partnership



Roadmap R&I FNSSA

- 1. Sustainable Intensification
- 2. Agriculture and food systems for nutrition
- 3. Expansion and improvement of agricultural markets and trade
- 4. Cross cutting issues
 - (Adding value to what exist; facilitating innovation process; strengthening R&I capacities; ensuring partnership governance adaptation)
 - ADOPTED the roadmap towards the Research and Innovation Partnership on food and nutrition security and sustainable agriculture (FNSSA), in 2016.
 - REQUESTED the Bureau to start work towards defining the next priority area;

HLPD Ministerial Meeting 2020

1. Public health, focusing on equitable access to new COVID-19 diagnostics, therapeutics and vaccines, as well as on the role of the European and Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership (EDCTP) in building the capacity of Sub-Saharan-African countries to conduct robust clinical trials.

2. Green transition, on the importance of investing into a green and sustainable economy through R&I Partnerships and boost the implementation of R&I Partnerships on Food and Nutrition Security and Sustainable Agriculture and Climate Change and Sustainable Energy (CCSE)

3. Innovation & technology, a more recent domain of cooperation between the two continents, highly relevant in the recovery phase. It features successful initiatives such as the Africa-Europe Innovation Partnership, the EU-Africa Digital innovation hubs (showcasing digital solutions with links to the Digital Education action plan), and support to the African Research and Education networks infrastructure.

4. Capacities for science, on the role of: open science (open sharing and open access to scientific data; support to African scientific networks for enhanced science policy advising; gender equality; human capital development (including researchers' mobility and training).

'AU-EU Innovation Partnership': to foster collaborative alliances and relationships between our continents under the AU-EU high level policy dialogue on STI, aiming to strengthen cross-cutting innovation cooperation between the EU and the AU
